Home- School Agreement

Dear Parents

Our 'Home-School Agreement' has been developed over time with contributions from representative staff, pupils, governors, children and parents.

This agreement is regularly updated. All families are invited to sign on beginning their school career with us.

A home-school agreement is a statement explaining:

- the school's aims and values;
- the school's responsibilities towards its pupils who are of compulsory school age;
- the responsibility of each pupil's parents; and
- what the school expects of its pupils.

ALL schools are required, by law, to have a 'Home-School Agreement'.

The Agreement reflects the importance of the partnership between home and school.

We have spent time discussing the Agreement with our children and explaining the responsibilities of everyone involved.

We ask you to read and share this agreement with your child. As Head Teacher I have signed each Agreement on behalf of the staff at school to show our dedication to the partnership. We ask you to discuss the agreement at home and then, with your child, sign the agreement in the appropriate places. Please then return the copy of the Agreement to school.

We will then make a copy and return one to you at home and keep one here at school as further evidence of our constructive working partnership between child, home and school.

Please note that one signature from either parent only is necessary and will be seen as a positive response from everyone at home in association with your child.
